



Object Code Restrictions

Purpose

Use this quick reference guide to determine what types of codes the object code restriction portion of your reporting responsibility allows you to report on.

If Your Reporting Responsibility Contains	Then you can report on
BE-S	Balance sheet, non-operating, and expense object codes minus all salary and fringe except casual
BFIE	Balance forwards (no balance sheet), non-operating, income, and expense object codes
BFIE-F	Balance forwards (no balance sheet), non-operating, income, and expense object codes minus faculty salary and fringe
BFIE-FE	Balance forwards (no balance sheet), non-operating, income, and expense object codes minus faculty and exempt salary and fringe
BFIE-S	Balance forwards (no balance sheet), non-operating, income, and expense object codes minus all salary and fringe except casual
BI	All balance sheet, non-operating, and income object codes
BIE	All balance sheet, non-operating, income, and expense object codes
BIE-F	Balance sheet, non-operating, income, and expense object codes minus faculty salary and fringe
BIE-FE	Balance sheet, non-operating, income, and expense object codes minus faculty and exempt salary and fringe
BIE-S	Balance sheet, non-operating, income, and expense object codes minus all salary and fringe except casual
E-S	Expense object codes minus all salary and fringe except casual
G650	Equipment object codes only that are grouped within giga parent object code G650
IE	All income and expense object codes
